STUDENT ILLNESS

Policy: Students are not allowed to remain in school when presenting signs of illness. Parent or guardian is to be called as soon as possible and is to assume responsibility for home care.

Signs of Illness:

1. Temperature 100° or above
2. Diarrhea
3. Vomiting
4. Rash
5. Drainage or crusting of eyes
6. Any contagious disease or infection
7. Cold symptoms with fever
8. Inability to follow normal daily routine due to signs of illness

Students may return to school after illness when:

1. Temperature has been normal (98.6°) for at least 24 hours without Tylenol.
2. Diarrhea has stopped for at least 24 hours.
3. Vomiting has stopped *and* normal eating has returned for at least 24 hours.
4. A rash has been diagnosed by physician *and* is not contagious.
5. Eye drainage or crusting has been treated with antibiotic eye drops or ointment for at least 24 hours.
6. Antibiotic treatment for strep throat has been in place for at least 24 hours.
